

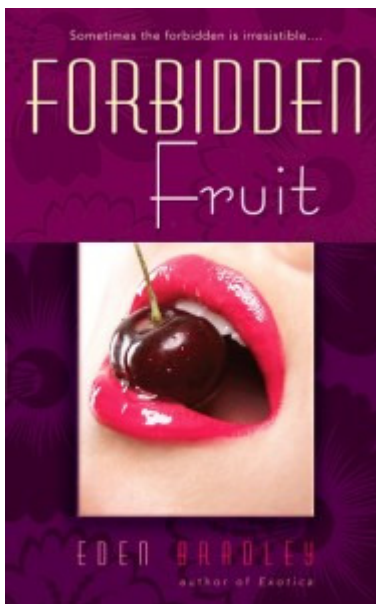
EDEN BRADLEY IS HERE TO TEMPT US AND A GIVEAWAY OF FORBIDDEN FRUIT

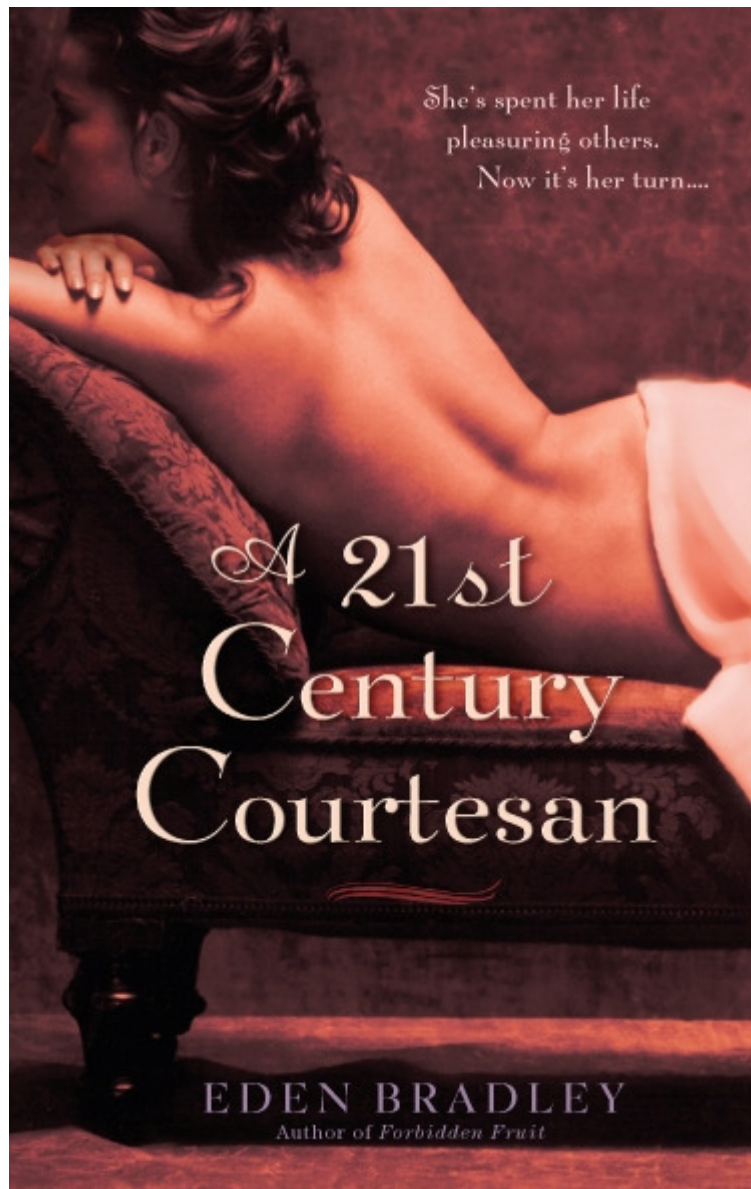

EDEN’S INTERVIEW

BK: Thank you for joining us, Eden!

What is sure to distract you from sitting down and working/writing?

My own lack of discipline! I love to write, but I’m easily distracted by too many things. I love to hang out at Romance Divas, the writer’s forum I help manage. I love to shop for shoes online. And my new boyfriend is a terrible distraction. Or a lovely one, depending on how you look at it.

BK: What are you working on presently? What about upcoming releases?

EB: Right now I’m doing some revisions on THE BEAUTY OF SURRENDER, my erotic Japanese bondage novel, which will be out in October. I’m also working on a proposal for a book I hope to sell in the next few weeks-you’ll have to check my website for news about that one. Next up is my first full-length novel for Harlequin Spice. The working title is THE LOVERS, but that could change. That book will be very different from anything else I’ve done before, and I can’t wait to really dig in!

BK: What’s the best compliment you ever got on your writing or a book?

That my writing made someone cry. I know that sounds awful, but it's wonderful to know my work was able to touch someone so deeply. Oh-and one woman told me she couldn't get through five pages of my book without having to retreat to her bedroom to masturbate-a high compliment for an erotica author!

BK: Sounds as though you are definitely hitting two very important buttons with your books. :) If you could time travel to any time or place—the past or future—where and when would you go to, and why?

EB: It would be interesting to see the future, but I'd be afraid of what I'd find there. And I'm fascinated by certain eras in the past. Ancient Egypt would be pretty amazing. I'd love to see the library at Alexandria at its height, where people from all over the world came to, assembling their knowledge. The ancient Egyptians were so advanced for their time, in art and medicine and architecture.

BK: I agree with you on all accounts there. I'd be right there with you cueing up to get into the lost library of Alexandria.
